

Technical Support: Classrooms

The Don Wright Faculty of Music maintains numerous classroom spaces. These are equipped with a variety of teach aids. Video cameras, data projection, audio playback, and overhead projectors are pre-positioned in many of these spaces. Equipment is securely locked in cabinets with 4 digit combination locks. These lock codes are available for sign out to Faculty members from the Main Office reception TC210. Details of for each space can be seen below. Further information and special needs should be addressed to music-tech@uwo.ca

Locks Locks open only after the code has been selected *then*, lock must be compressed to open.

Data Projection - Data/DLP projectors may need an adaptor if input is from a 'Mac' computer. Users are encouraged to provide their own adaptors - however there are adaptors in the classrooms and with sign out projectors

When playing embedded video through a data projector, one may encounter no video being displayed although it still appears on the source or laptop screen. Many laptops are not able to accommodate this demand. Solution - toggle off laptop LCD display and thus devote all video card resources to the external video projector.

Video Cameras Recorded SD Card video from Faculty cameras can be played back on many computer systems, such as Windows 7. When wanting to play via computer an SD card slot, or USB card reader is needed. These cameras will work with the slower speed 2 or 4 cards. (this number is located within an upper case 'C' on the card) In addition, SD card video playback is available in the Music Library TC234H.
